

Obama's Position On Issues

Abortion: Supports Roe v. Wade¹ and the “Freedom of Choice Act” that would nullify federal, state, and local restrictions on abortion and make abortion a constitutional right.²

Human Life Amendment: Opposes a federal amendment to ban abortion and supports unrestricted access to abortion in all states.³

Partial-Birth Abortion: Supports partial-birth abortion.⁴

Taxpayer-Funded Abortion: Supports taxpayer-funded abortions.⁵

Born-Alive Infant Protection Act: Opposes legislation giving infants who survive an attempted abortion the right-to-life.⁶

Parental Notification: Opposes legislation requiring parents to be notified if their child requests an abortion.⁷

Embryonic Stem Cell Research: Supports both the destruction of embryos for research purposes and the use of federal funds to so.⁸

Human Cloning: Supports human cloning for embryonic stem cell research.⁹

Judicial Philosophy: Supports appointing judges who view the U.S. Constitution as a living document and interpret it according to changing values and culture.¹⁰

Federal Marriage Amendment: Opposes a U.S. constitutional amendment to define marriage as the union of one man and one woman and believes the decision should be left for the states to decide.¹¹

Defense of Marriage: Opposes D.O.M.A. which protects a state's right to decide for themselves whether or not to recognize same-sex “marriage” and believes D.O.M.A. should be repealed.¹²

Federal Estate Tax: Supports estate or “death” taxes.¹³

Moral Education: Supports educational curriculum that promotes homosexuality.¹⁴
